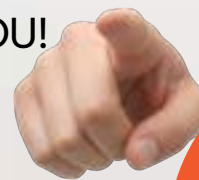

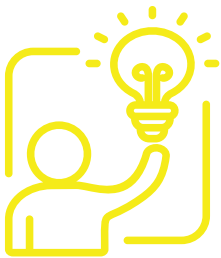
Phase 1: Outcome

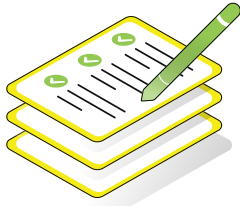


Final Outcome

Be creative and submit the following:

- Essays or Reflection essays
- Photos or Videos
- Reference or endorsement letters

Criteria 1: Leadership

Essay (300 - 500 words): Describe a situation where you:

- Took initiative, Led or influenced others
- Solved a problem creatively

Short Video (2–3 minutes) - Explain: What leadership means to you, How you lead among your peers

Reference or Endorsement Letter: From a teacher, coach, youth leader, pastor, community leader, or mentor: Must confirm leadership behaviour and peer influence

- Proof of Leadership Roles: Prefect, Team captain, Peer mentor

- Who benefited
- Why you chose to get involved

Photos or Media Evidence

- Images of participation (with consent where required)
- Screenshots of posts, posters, or announcements

- Confirming participation or volunteer work

Activity Log (optional)

- Dates, activities, and hours involved

2. Participants must be currently enrolled in a school or a home school programme.
3. Each participant may self-nominate or be nominated by someone else with entire's permission.
4. Participants must submit an entry fee of R100.
5. All entries must provide evidence for the two main criteria:
 - a. Leadership (initiative, creativity, peer influence)
 - b. Charity / community involvement (helping others, volunteering, acts of kindness)
6. Bonus points can be earned for:
 - a. Eco-friendly / environmental activities
 - b. Selling Tutela vehicle raffle tickets (highest seller gets extra points)
7. Entries must be complete, honest, and submitted by the closing date: 20 February 2026.
8. Participants must have signed parental or legal guardian consent if under 18.
9. Tutela reserves the right to disqualify any entry that does not meet these rules or is fraudulent.
10. All entries must commit to complete phase 2 of the competition if entering this competition.
